- Create a revision timetable but not working to an unreasonable hour.
- Create a learning space similar to the exam environment (silence with no distractions).
- Make sure each revision session is 30 – 45 minutes long.
- Make the most of the different Apps that are available for each subject.
- Use Class Charts to support their learning.Parents can also access Class Charts and discuss their progress with them.
