Dear Parent/Carer

As you will be aware, after the recent briefing detailing plans for Stage 4 of the easing of Covid-19 restrictions, the new operational guidance for schools has been released. This guidance could potentially change, but I am keen to share the plans for when students return in September. **These measures will only come into effect at the academy when we return after the summer break.**

The key points from the guidance are;

- There is no requirement to keep students in year group bubbles. This means that all students will start and finish at the same time arriving before 8.35am and finishing at 2.40pm. The student entry point will open at 8.05am and all students will enter through the main "Standards Gate" next to the small car park.
- There is no requirement to keep year groups separate at unstructured times such as break and lunchtimes, which means we will no longer have the three break / lunchtimes. Due to the academy being oversubscribed in Years 7, 8, 9, 12 and 13, we will continue to run **two** split break/lunchtime with year groups assigned to certain dining rooms but students will be able to mix more freely at those times.
- Students will no longer be located in certain blocks for their lessons. Instead students will move between the faculty blocks during lesson changeover.
- Face coverings will no longer be advised in communal areas or classrooms. If a student or a
 member of staff would like to wear a face covering we will, of course, support this request.
- From Monday 16 August, children under the age of eighteen will no longer need to self-isolate if they have been in close contact with a positive case. The academy will not be asked to run any form of Test and Trace. Students with symptoms should self-isolate until the result of a PCR test and if positive will be required to self-isolate. Students will be contacted by the NHS Test and Trace if they have been in close contact and asked to take a PCR test but will be able to continue attending the academy.

The guidance has also requested that students are tested twice on their return to the academy. The first test will take place before students return. This means there will be a staggered return to the academy in September. Priority is being given to Year 7, who have been unable to have the usual three days of transition due to the Covid-19 restrictions.
