Dear Parents & Carers

You will be aware that on Wednesday 19 January, it was announced that students and staff are no longer required to wear face coverings in classrooms from Thursday 20 January. It was also announced that from Thursday 27 January, students and staff would no longer be required to wear face coverings on corridors or in communal areas. This guidance may change; if the Local Authority and Public Health determine there is a localised outbreak, face coverings may then be reintroduced.

Throughout the pandemic, I have been very clear that I will always follow the guidance and so face coverings will no longer be required anywhere on site from Thursday 27 January.

St Helens is still experiencing a high number of cases, this is reflected in staff and student absence. With this in mind, we will support any staff and students who wish to continue to wear face coverings anywhere across site.
