Zentangle Insects Term 1	Students will develop an understanding for the formal elements of Art. Colour Theory, Drawing skills and Mark Making.	If possible provide a broad range of creative materials for home use. E.g. Shading pencils, Acrylic & Watercolour paints, collage papers, glue, scissors,

		Provide a clear flat working space that has a protective surface for art homework to be completed on.

Native American Art	Students will develop an understanding about Native American Art and its culture. They will investigate the varied characteristics within Native	Research into relevant artists, concepts or cultures.
Term 2	American Art and develop their own views/ opinions. Skills: Pattern, Print Making, Drawing, Colour, Cardboard manipulation, Low reliefs, Clay manipulation, Painting, Three dimensional sculpture. A low relief cardboard mask inspired by Native American art will be produced.	Visits to local, national or international galleries and exhibitions (Walker Art Gallery, The Tate, Museum of Liverpool, The World Museum)
		Visit to The World Museum, Liverpool to view the insect exhibition.
