

Curriculum Overview – Year 10 Art

Unit Title	Learning	How can parents best support?
Birds – GCSE Coursework completion Half Term 1	Students will continue to develop their ideas and create three dimensional bird models in a range of mediums.	Regularly check SMHW deadlines for Art homework. Ensure that your child is well equipped for both school and home learning. If students require any additional art materials for their coursework projects these can be purchased through the art department or alternatively retail shops such as: Hobby craft, The Range, Rennies Art Store and Cass Art. Provide a clear flat working space that has a protective surface for art homework to be completed on.
Steampunk – GCSE Coursework-2 nd Sustained Project Half Term 2-6	Students will investigate and research the genre steampunk and source images that can be used and manipulated to produce work in the Steampunk style. Educational Trips: Chester Zoo and The Science and Industry Museum Using primary source photographs students will begin a range of initial observational drawings (A03) exploring a range of relevant mediums. Students will be introduced to a range of steampunk artists (A01) and images and will be required to research, analyse, present and interpret work and create ideas. Exploring a range of different mediums (A02) in a workshop style to develop personal ideas (A04) that link directly the students focussed area. Students will develop a range of design ideas that are specific to their chosen imagery (photographs, PINTEREST, Museum images).	Direction towards appropriate websites that have a suitable level of detail (relevant to school projects and homework, in particular PINTEREST). Research into relevant artists, concepts or cultures. Visits to local, national or international galleries and exhibitions (Walker Art Gallery, The Tate, Museum of Liverpool, The World Museum) Encourage your child to attend Art Club once a week to seek additional support or to complete class works and homework where necessary.
