Bird Project- Sustained GCSE project Term 2&3	Students will research and investigate the theme birds. Students will photograph a range of birds and begin initial observational drawings exploring a range of wet and dry mediums. Students will be introduced to a range of artists and will be required to research, analyse, presentation and interpretation of work and creating ideas based upon their research and artists. Students will select a particular species of bird to focus on and will create a series of large scale outcomes. Students will develop their ideas and create three dimensional bird models in a range of mediums.
