Dear Parent/Carer

As a way of supporting your child and their learning, I would like to invite them to participate in our reading intervention support sessions.

The sessions will take place during Ready to Learn from 8.35am-8.55am. Students are expected to attend two sessions per week, with the sessions outlined on their timetable. New timetables will be handed out next week, with sessions starting from Monday morning.

The sessions will focus on developing reading, inference and prediction skills which aim to improve a student's confidence, fluency and comprehension when reading. This will involve students exploring a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts and completing a series of questions to develop student's understanding. Reading material will be personalised for each student based on their reading age.

Reading is recognised worldwide as the biggest barrier to raising attainment and achievement. It is, therefore, a priority that every student is able to access every curriculum across the school to enable them to fulfil their potential.
