Dear Parent/Carer

This half-term your child will be sitting assessments to inform Tracking-1 for this academic year. These will take place week commencing Monday 20 October, and will be held during lesson time. Subject teachers will inform students of when these will be taking place.

These assessments are especially important for students in Year 10 as this is the first time they will have been assessed against their Key Stage 4 options. The performance in these assessments will help teachers to create end of key stage predicted grades for all students which we will share with students and parents/carers in their Tracking 1 reports.

We expect all students to prepare for these assessments so that they are a positive experience. This week, your child has been issued with a Tracking-1 Revision Booklet, which contains all of the information they need to do well. This booklet contains revision lists for each subject, along with associated resources and tasks. Now that students are studying for their Key Stage 4 options, we have rebranded 'homework tasks'. This will now be referred to as '**Tracking Prep Tasks**' to help students associate completing their 'homework' with helping them to prepare for their tracking assessments. It is essential that all students in Year 10 complete all **Tracking Prep Tasks** to the best of their ability.

All students in Year 10 are eligible to be nominated for the **Revision Revolution** challenge. If they provide examples of independent revision, they will receive a nomination. They will be awarded 10+ Achievement Points on ClassCharts. The high value tariff attached to this reward reflects the value we place on revision and independent learning at the academy. Within each year group, there will be a voucher awarded to the student who has received the most nominations.

We are proud of the work we do at the academy to support students during their assessments and hope that we can work in strong partnership with parents/carers to secure the very best outcomes for your child.
