We are delighted to announce that on Friday 7 November, Year 13 students will be attending the University and Apprenticeship Careers Fair at Liverpool Football Club.

This provides students with a registration QR code. They must keep this safe in their emails and I advise that they should screen shot it and even print to ensure entrance on the day.

The purpose of the trip is for students to attend the Fair and speak to representatives from various universities, apprenticeships and careers. There are current staff as well as past and present students/trainees, so that Year 13 students have detailed information to allow them to make informed decisions about their own destinations.

We plan to leave the academy at 10.10am on Friday 7 November and return at approximately 2.00pm to allow for students to make their own way home as usual.

The trip is fully funded for attendance and transport. Students will need to fund any drinks or food they may wish to buy once there.
