

Tracking-2 Assessments - Week Commencing Monday 2 February

Dear Parents/Carers

This half-term student first name will be sitting Tracking-2 assessments in all subjects, week commencing Monday 2 February. Details regarding the day/days each paper will be sat in each subject will be shared with student first name by their class teacher.

The purpose of these assessments is to inform student's Tracking-2 Reports and to identify what they do and do not know, so that any gaps in knowledge and misconceptions can be addressed. For those subjects that are tiered. or streamed by ability, these assessments will also inform any set changes or examination tiers.

We expect all students to fully prepare for these assessments so that they are a positive experience. This week, your child has been issued with a Tracking-2 Revision Booklet which contains all the information they need to do well. This booklet contains revision lists for each subject along with associated resources and tasks. If your child misplaces their booklet, they will be able to access this electronically on the school website. It is also important to note, that all home learning tasks set in the lead up to assessments are revision-based tasks, so it is especially important that your child completes all home learning tasks promptly.

All students in Year 10 are eligible to be nominated for the **Revision Revolution** challenge. If they bring in examples of independent revision they have completed and show any member of staff, they will receive a nomination. They will be awarded 10+ Achievement Points on Class Charts. The high value tariff attached to this reward, reflects the value we place on revision and independent learning at the academy. Within each year group, there will be a voucher awarded to the student who has received the most nominations.

We are proud of the work we do here at the academy to support students during their assessments and hope that we can work in strong partnership with yourself to secure the very best outcomes for your child.
