These sessions are run by subject experts and have been designed meticulously by teachers to address any gaps in knowledge or misconceptions. We strongly believe that these sessions are vital to student success, so attendance to Boost & Secure is mandatory.

Personalised Intervention Programme

This year, we are introducing an exciting new approach to supporting our Year 11 students. For the first time, our usual Ready to Learn groups will be replaced with a Personalised Intervention Programme, ensuring every student receives targeted support in the subject where it will have the greatest impact on their final GCSE outcomes.

Using information from students' end of Year 10 mock examinations and Tracking-3 point, each student will be allocated to a specialist intervention group in the subject that is identified as their highest priority. Intervention groups will be available in English, Mathematics, Science, Geography, History and Spanish and will be reviewed after Year 11 Tracking-1 to ensure they continue to meet each student's needs.

These intervention sessions will take place during Ready to Learn time, four mornings each week, meaning students receive additional teaching without reducing curriculum time in their other subjects. To maximise the impact of these sessions, intervention groups will have an average size of around 12 students. This enables our expert teachers to deliver highly targeted teaching, quickly address misconceptions and provide personalised feedback and support to every student.
