Bay of Naples Trip - Update and Information Evening

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you of a small update to the upcoming Bay of Naples trip.

Originally, our return flight with easyJet was scheduled for 3.10pm on Wednesday 15 April, this was changed last week to 6.00am, which meant we would lose most of the final night and the full last day. I did not want to do this given how much I had negotiated when the trip changed last year. However, I have been able to negotiate a flight change, and we are now returning on an evening Ryanair flight instead. This change gives us an additional afternoon in the Bay of Naples that was not originally planned for.

To ensure students can make the most of this extra time, we have arranged an additional educational visit on the final day. This will provide a structured, safe, and worthwhile activity. I have negotiated as much as possible with NST but because of the added transport and entry costs, we kindly ask for an additional contribution of **£15 per student**. This will be listed on Arbor as a separate payment from the trip and will need to be paid by Friday 13 March please. If you have any queries, please contact me by email.

I am pleased to invite you to attend an information evening with your child in April to discuss the fast-approaching trip to the Bay of Naples. I know that students are eager to hear more details, and this evening will allow us to share all of the information on the upcoming trip so that you know what to expect; and to answer any questions that you may have.

The information evening will be held in the Technology Plaza in the main academy building on Wednesday 25 February, from 5.15pm to 5.45pm. We would appreciate the attendance of as many students and their families as possible please.
