We are fortunate to have a very skilful and experienced governing body and would welcome a parent governor who can bring their own unique experiences, perspectives and insights into decision making in the interests of the academy community. I would also like to draw your attention to the term dates as published on our website. For the academic year 2019/20 the October half term is slightly later than usual, this is to ensure that our holiday periods are in line with other local schools. Finally I am pleased to confirm our much improved position regarding external examination results. Based on the progress our students made in the 2018 GCSE results we are ranked fourth within St Helens Local Authority, outperforming our local competitors.

Post 16, our students performed in line with national average at A Level and above average in vocational qualifications, second best in the authority, again outperforming all our competitor schools.
