Dear Parents & Carers

As discussed in previous correspondence, I am keen to keep all parents and carers fully informed on the ever-changing Covid 19 picture.

Today a student in Year 7 received a positive test for Covid 19. With the increase in cases across the country, this was an event we were expecting. We have been in contact with the Local Authority and Public Health England to provide all the necessary information regarding the movement and interactions during the day. This included reviewing any students who were in close contact with the infected student within 48 hours of symptoms starting. This included Thursday 10 and Friday 11 September.

To ensure we keep all stakeholders at the academy safe, we have been advised to ask 46 Year 7 students to self-isolate for 14 days from 11 September.

You are receiving this letter as your child has **not** been in close contact with the student and so there is no need to self-isolate. They are to continue attending the academy as normal.

If your child does develop any of the three Covid 19 symptoms, please follow the poster the academy shared on 9 September for further guidance.
