The Sutton Academy extra-curricular programme provides students with a broad, exciting and aspirational programme. It includes sporting clubs, as well a wide range of weekly subject specific offerings.

What is extra-curricular?

Although formal lessons end at 2.40pm, the academy day does not. Students can choose from a fantastic range of academic and non-academic end-of-day activities and clubs.

All sessions are run by staff and may vary in length depending on the activity.

The Extra-Curricular Programme at the academy is overseen by Mrs Egerton, who is always happy to help with any queries.

Why attend extra-curricular?

There are two main reasons to attend extra-curricular activities. Firstly, the catch up and revision sessions are a fantastic tool to help accelerate your academic achievement.
